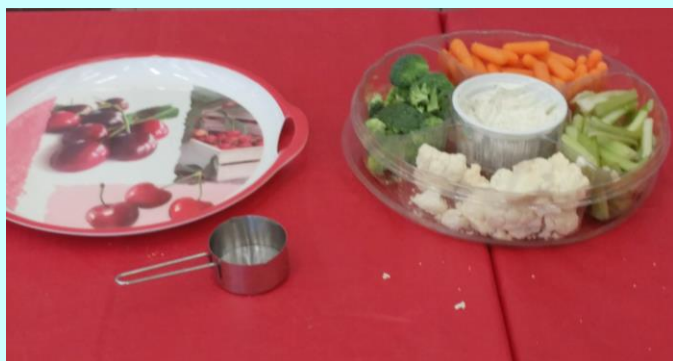

Kevin and Anita Cotter, Jim and Janet Tedford presented a very informative slide show and talk about their trip/pilgrimage to Israel, Jordan and the Palestinian Territories in fall of 2017. They highlighted some of the 51 sites that they visited on their 2-week bus tour. The focus was mainly on biblically significant sites or places of great historical interest. Amongst the places of note were Bethlehem, Nazareth, Jerusalem, Cana, Mount of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, Sea of Galilee, Jordan River, Dead Sea, Petra and Masada. They touched briefly on the importance of these sites to modern day Christians as well as the ancient world. They noted that it is an amazing area to visit, and that Jordan, in particular is spending millions of dollars, hoping to get the tourist trade back up and running after many years of neglect.
